Father/Daughter Dance

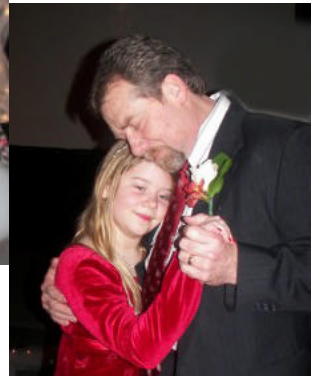
