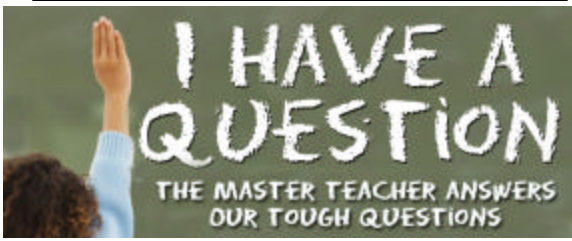


## Current Sermon Series

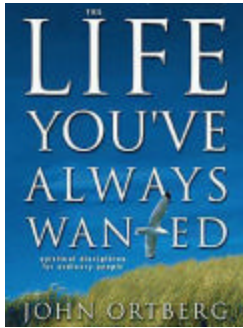

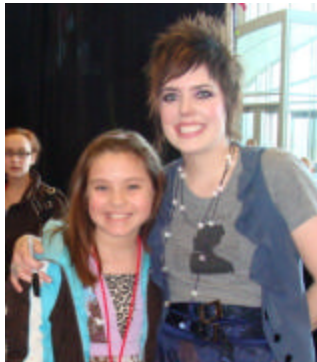

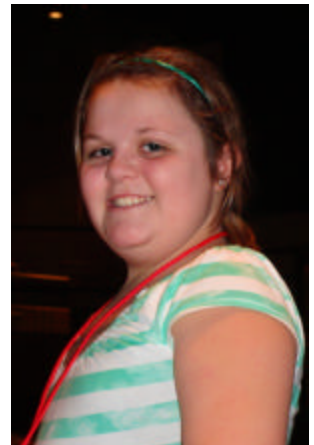
